The internal assessment of Drug Abuse and Environment papers is based on assignments, the questions for which can be downloaded from www.dccpbi.com. It is compulsory for every student to prepare and submit the assignments of Drug Abuse and Environment in the department before the due date i.e. 08-11-2019.

Two personal contact programmes (PCP) of 5 days will be held to provide intensive class room teaching and personal guidance. It is **compulsory** for every student to attend at least **75% lectures** in the Personal Contact Programmes.
